



Tuition & Financial Aid 2019-2020

Our tuition for the 2018-2019 school year is \$3,950.00 for students in grades K-8. This rate of \$3,950.00 is **BEFORE** any *parish subsidy, diocesan financial aid, and tuition reimbursement through the Stop & Shop gift card program*. Subsidies, financial aid, and any credits are applied towards tuition **AFTER** approval and/or obligations have been met.

Tuition before credits:	\$3950.00
Parish Subsidy:	- 650.00 (credit is <u>per child</u> in K-8 only)

TUITION: **\$3300.00* per K-8 student**

*Stop & Shop Tuition Reduction Program participants will have an additional credit that is applied twice per year.

Payment Options: Pay in full to the school by August 15th

FACTS Automatic Tuition Deduction Program

- Plan A: 12 monthly payments beginning July ending June
- Plan B: 10 monthly payments beginning July ending April
- Plan C: 10 monthly payments beginning September ending June

A **non-refundable** registration fee of \$38.00-\$52.00 per family is due at the time of FACTS application. Please note, your application will **not** be processed until the fee is received. ***The fee will be applied to your annual tuition.***

Diocesan Financial Aid

Diocesan Financial Aid is available for students Kindergarten through grade eight. Diocesan Financial Aid will be applied to tuition upon notification from the Diocese of Springfield. Families need only one application to cover all their children enrolled in our Diocesan elementary and high schools.

To qualify for Diocesan Financial Aid, you must:

- be an active member of a Catholic Parish in the Diocese of Springfield;
- demonstrate financial need within the Diocesan guidelines;
- actively support and attend your Parish Church and have approval from your pastor;
- complete the financial aid application each year (available on-line at factstuitionaid.com); and pay an application fee.

Discounts, parish subsidies, and financial aid are available for qualifying families and will be applied to tuition after approval has been met.
