

Covid-19 Testing & Quarantine

If you have Covid-like symptoms - we require a PCR test.

Please be advised that we do not accept rapid tests.

SYMPTOMS:

If you choose to test:

NEGATIVE PCR TEST - return to school 24 hrs. after symptoms improve and fever free for 24 hrs. without medication

POSITIVE - return to school on **day 11 from symptom onset**, after symptoms improve, and fever free for 24 hrs. without medication.

If you choose NOT to test:

QUARANTINE at home for 10 days from symptom onset and come back to school on day 11 after symptoms improve and fever free for 24 hrs. without medication.

CLOSE CONTACTS - If you are a close contact but **NOT living** with the positive person

If you choose to test:

NEGATIVE PCR TEST - return to school after negative result if no symptoms or 24 hrs. after symptoms improve and fever free for 24 hrs. without medication

POSITIVE - return to school on **day 11 from symptom onset or last exposure** and after symptoms improve and fever free for 24 hrs. without medication.

If you choose NOT to test:

QUARANTINE at home and come back to school on day 11 after symptoms improve and fever free for 24 hrs. without medication.

CLOSE CONTACTS - If you are a close contact **and live** with the positive person you must stay home for the duration of **their isolation**. Your exposure date is the LAST DAY of the positive person's isolation. If you have no symptoms at the end of their isolation, you can return to school after receiving a negative PCR test. If symptoms develop, follow protocols for a symptomatic individual.

In addition to these guidelines, if your child is sent home or is staying home due to seasonal allergies, a doctor's note must be provided in order to return to school.
