Covid-19 Testing & Quarantine

If you have Covid-like symptoms - we require a <u>PCR</u> test.

Please be advised that we do not accept <u>rapid</u> tests.

SYMPTOMS:

If you choose to test:

<u>NEGATIVE PCR TEST</u> - return to school 24 hrs. after symptoms improve and fever free for 24 hrs. without medication

<u>POSITIVE</u> - return to school on **day 11** *from symptom onset*, after symptoms improve, and fever free for 24 hrs. without medication.

If you choose NOT to test:

<u>QUARANTINE</u> at home for 10 days from symptom onset and come back to school on day 11 after symptoms improve and fever free for 24 hrs. without medication.

<u>CLOSE CONTACTS</u> - If you are a close contact but <u>NOT living</u> with the positive person

If you choose to test:

<u>NEGATIVE PCR TEST</u> - return to school after negative result if no symptoms or 24 hrs. after symptoms improve and fever free for 24 hrs. without medication

<u>POSITIVE</u> - return to school on **day 11** *from symptom onset or last exposure* and after symptoms improve and fever free for 24 hrs. without medication.

If you choose NOT to test:

<u>OUARANTINE</u> at home and come back to school on day 11 after symptoms improve and fever free for 24 hrs. without medication.

<u>CLOSE CONTACTS</u> - If you are a close contact <u>and live</u> with the positive

person you must stay home for the duration of <u>their isolation</u>. Your exposure date is the LAST DAY of the positive person's isolation. If you have no symptoms at the end of their isolation, you can return to school after receiving a negative PCR test. If symptoms develop, follow protocols for a symptomatic individual.

In addition to these guidelines, if your child is sent home or is staying home due to <u>seasonal allergies</u>, a doctor's note must be provided in order to return to school.
