

# Covid-19 Testing & Quarantine

*If you have Covid-like symptoms - we require a PCR test.*

*Please be advised that we do not accept rapid tests.*

## SYMPTOMS:

### **If you choose to test:**

NEGATIVE PCR TEST - return to school 24 hrs. after symptoms improve and fever free for 24 hrs. without medication

POSITIVE - isolate for 10 days and return to school on **day 11 from symptom onset**, after symptoms improve, and fever free for 24 hrs. without medication.

### **If you choose NOT to test:**

QUARANTINE at home for 10 days from symptom onset and come back to school on day 11 after symptoms improve and fever free for 24 hrs. without medication.

## CLOSE CONTACTS - If you are a close contact but NOT living with the positive person

### **If you choose to test:**

NEGATIVE PCR TEST - return to school after negative result if no symptoms or 24 hrs. after symptoms improve and fever free for 24 hrs. without medication

POSITIVE - isolate for 10 days and return to school on **day 11 from symptom onset or last exposure** and after symptoms improve and fever free for 24 hrs. without medication.

### **If you choose NOT to test:**

QUARANTINE at home for 10 days and come back to school on day 11 after symptoms improve and fever free for 24 hrs. without medication.

## CLOSE CONTACTS - If you are a close contact and live with the positive person you must stay home and quarantine for the duration of their 10 day

isolation. If you have no symptoms at the end of their 10 day isolation, you can return to school after receiving a negative PCR test on day 5 or later. If symptoms develop, follow protocols for a symptomatic individual.

***In addition to these guidelines, if your child is sent home or is staying home due to seasonal allergies, a doctor's note must be provided in order to return to school.***
