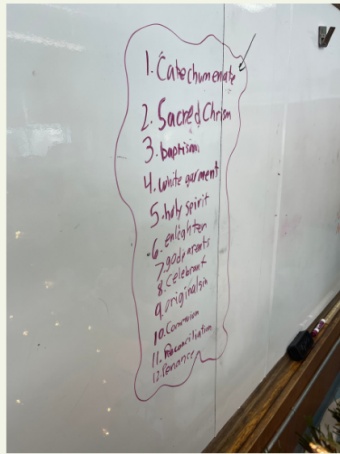


MR. CARANDO'S NEWSLETTER
