Language Arts

In Language Arts, we have been working with different types of pronouns including subject, object, and possessive. This quarter we will be focusing on adjectives and adverbs as we work to add descriptive language to our writing. We will see examples of metaphors and similes as we dive into the genres of poetry and tall tales.

Science

In Science class, we have been learning about the structures and functions of living things. Students explored how plants use their structures to survive, grow, and reproduce. They investigated whether different plants have the same structures. Our studies will also include the structures and functions of animals and various adaptations that help animals survive.

Social Studies

We completed our journey through the Southeast region and students are completing a postcard project to wrap up the unit. The states and capitals for the Midwest have been introduced and we have started learning about the landforms and climate in the Midwest region. The history and people who contributed to the development of the region will also be explored. The United States is a beautiful and interesting country to learn about.

Math

After completing a unit on division, students explored factors and multiples to prepare them to work with fractions. We have spent time on fraction concepts so we can move on to adding and subtracting fractions and mixed numbers. We will also move on to a unit on decimals in which we will learn decimal place value so that we can compare and order decimals.
